### MINUTES FOR FIFTEENTH MEETING OF IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEE FOR NATIONAL CLEAN AIR PROGRAMME

The Fifteenth Meeting of the Implementation Committee was convened on 24.11.2023 through video conferencing under the Chairmanship of the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) to oversee the implementation of actions carried out under NCAP.

At the outset, Chairman, CPCB welcomed all the Implementation Committee Members and discussed about the state-wise pending issues as well as pre-requisites for release of fund for FY 23-24. The key points of discussion were expeditious utilisation of 75 % of funds for FY 22-23, generation of UC on PRANA, submission of State level Implementation & Monitoring Committees report, pre-requisites and general entry level conditions for release of XVFC funds, Annual Action Plan for FY 22-23 & 23-24, Quarterly progress reports for FY 22-23 & FY 23-24, Submission of State Action Plans, Hotspots identification & Action Plan, Minutes of Steering Committee, Monitoring Committee, District/City Level Implementation Committee (DLIC/CLIC) meetings, signed MoUs and other pending information on PRANA. It was informed that submission of information will be considered through PRANA only and other mode of submission will not be accepted until and unless there are some issues with the portal.

AD-AQM briefed about the status of actions taken as per the last meeting, and outlined the issues pertaining to million plus and non-attainment cities under NCAP through the presentation.

SPCBs/PCCs representatives informed about the implementation status of various activities and timelines for completion of the pending work. The details are enclosed at **Annexure-I**

 PCC informed that UCs, Annual Action Plan for FY 23-24 and QPRs related data will be submitted soon.

### 4. Delhi:

- Dept. of Environment shared that the data related to UCs, AAP, QPR, Mission Life will be submitted in PRANA soon.
- MCD informed that 3 schemes were sanctioned. Out of this, 2 schemes are yet to get approval from standing committee, which is political wing and need to be constituted. Due to this, tenders are also not getting awarded.
- CPCB & MoEFCC shared that currently Delhi has low utilisation of fund and it needs at least 75% utilisation for further release of funds.

### 5. Gujarat:

- PCB informed that UCs of Vadodara City will be submitted within 2-3 working days.
- Rajkot Annual Action Plan will be revised.

### 6. Himachal Pradesh:

- PCB informed that they will submit Annual Action Plan for FY 2023-24 within a
  week.
- For FY 2022-23, QPR data will be submitted within a months' time.
- Damtal is a rural area and has no hotspot.

• 6 out of 7 cities of Himachal Pradesh have utilised more than 75% funds allotted but Damtal could not utilise the funds as it had flooded situation.

### 7. J&K:

- PCB informed that Annual Action Plan 23-24 data submission will be done by the end of the day.
- QPRs related data submission will also be done soon.
- Mission life data submission already done by Srinagar.
- Both cities Hotspot action plans are already prepared and will be uploaded on PRANA soon.
- UCs will be uploaded on PRANA soon.

### 8. Karnataka:

- SPCB informed that the Annual Action plan (AAP) has been prepared but approval awaited from state government for uploading it on PRANA.
- QPRs data will be submitted by the end of the month.
- Mission life module data will also be submitted within a week.
- Hotspots action plan will be updated based on SA study.
- Minutes of meetings are getting uploaded.
- UCs will be submitted by remaining 2 cities i.e. Bengaluru & Hubli-Dharwad
- ATS and RVSF will be included in the State Action Plan and Annual Action Plan.
- CPCB informed that AAP for FY 22-23 is awaited from Bengaluru. Karnataka SPCB needs to transfer the 2nd tranche of funds for FY 2023-24 released to ULB under NCAP.
- MoEFCC informed that no expenditure data has been submitted on PRANA by Bengaluru till date.

### 9. Madhya Pradesh:

- PCB informed that Dewas annual action plan needs to be revised and QPR data will be submitted in 10 days.
- Mission Life data will be submitted within one week.
- Data in Physical progress module will be submitted within one week.
- UC and expenditure data will be submitted after 1st week of December as the model code of conduct due to election is in place.

### 10. Maharashtra:

- PCB informed that revised Annual Action Plan 23-24 of cities will be submitted within 1-2 days.
- SPCB informed that QPRs data will be submitted in 15 days.

• Fund utilisation will be 64% by 30th November & will be uploaded on Prana.


