Minutes of the 15th Monitoring Committee Meeting on the Implementation of the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP)

The 15th Monitoring Committee Meeting to review the progress of implementation of the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) was convened on 29th August 2025, under the chairmanship of **Shri Neelesh Kumar Sah, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC)**. The list of participants is enclosed as **Annexure I**.

1. **Shri Neelesh Kumar Sah, Joint Secretary, MoEF&CC** welcomed all participants and outlined the agenda for the session as follows:
 - i. Status of preparation of Annual Action Plan for FY 2025-26 for 130 NCAP cities
 - ii. Status of submission of Saturation Action Plan for FY 2025-26 for 130 NCAP cities
 - iii. Status of fund utilization for 130 NCAP cities
2. A brief presentation on status of implementation of NCAP. Copy of the presentation is enclosed as **Annexure III**. Salient points are provided as below:
 - **Annual Action Plans (FY 2025–26):** Out of 130 NCAP cities, 35 have submitted Annual Action Plans. Of these, 4 plans have been approved, 20 referred back to cities for revision, and 11 are under review by CPCB. Remaining 95 cities are yet to submit their plans.
 - **Saturation Action Plans (FY 2025–26):** 91 cities have submitted their Saturation Action Plans. 39 cities are yet to submit or have submitted incomplete plans.
 - **Fund Utilisation Status:** Funds released amount to ₹13,236.80 Cr, to 130 cities of which ₹9,769.83 Cr has been utilised, reflecting an overall utilisation rate of 74%.

- **City-Wise Fund Utilisation:** 65 cities have reported expenditure between 50–75%, 13 cities between 25–50%, 2 cities below 25% on PRANA portal.
 - **Funding Criteria for FY 2025–26:** For the FY 2025-26, fund disbursement to 82 cities will be based on a revised Air Quality Challenge Method. This includes fulfilment of pre-qualification criteria, implementation of reform-based challenge criteria, and achievement of air quality performance indicators. CPCB has been requested to create a module on PRANA portal for operationalise and capturing compliance of the revised challenge method.
3. CPCB informed that a significant number of Annual Action Plans were returned to cities due to gaps in convergence details, inconsistencies in target setting, and inclusion of activities beyond the core NCAP framework. Additionally, Saturation Action Plans from 39 cities remain pending, necessitating focused follow-up to ensure timely and complete submission.
 4. Chair directed cities with referred-back plans to resubmit revised versions and urged completion of pending Saturation Action Plans. A minimum of 75% fund utilisation was mandated as part of pre-qualification criteria for accessing FY 2025–26 funds.
 5. City-specific feedback was discussed for those with fund utilisation below 50%. Cities shared their progress and committed timelines for achieving higher utilisation. The following intervention are made by state/cities
 - **Chandpur city** has attained the utilization of 61% against the utilization reported on PRANA which is 41%.
 - **Kurnool city** had informed that, the proposals for FY 2024-25 were approved in February 2025 and the bills are preparation. Utilization certificate for the same will be submitted within a month.
 - **Sibsagar city** intimated the estimates are under preparation for the action plan of FY 24-25 and stated that utilization will be expected to increase.
 - In **Jamshedpur**, fund utilization is at 44%. City informed that expenditure has reached up to 67%. Approval of 20 crore works have been sent to HLMIC and expenditure will increase upto 70%.

- Vijayawada city informed that bills of works having worth of Rs.37 crore are in process for release of funds, which will be expected to increase the utilization up to 70%. Further, the activities for Rs.37 crores are under implementation. Within a month, the city will cross the expenditure of 75%.
 - **Jammu** informed that, 33 works have been approved and 22 works were awarded for implementation.
 - **Faridabad** informed that current utilization is 41% and 100% utilization is expected within 3 months of time.
 - **Vishakhapatnam** has informed that utilization Certificate will be submitted within 15 days and utilization is expected to increase up to 75%.
 - **Jalandhar** has informed that current utilization is 36% and it will be improved within 2 months.
 - **Ujjain** intimated that multiple works are going on and the utilization will exceed by 50% by September 2025.
 - **Srinagar** submitted that tenders have been floated and utilization will be expected to improve this year.
 - **Gaya** reported that, utilization certificates will be uploaded within 15 days and utilization will increase to 65%. Further, utilization expected to increase to 80% in 3 months.
 - **Gulberga** reported that submitted that the utilization could be reached up to 54 % within 3 months of time.
 - **Delhi** intimated that, tendering for the works for the Rs.20 crore is completed and work order will be issued by 30th Sept. Also, plan for the ₹40 crore has been submitted for approval.
 - **Noida** informed that works could not be completed due to ongoing rainy season.
6. Bengaluru's Annual Action Plan for FY 24-25 has not been submitted. The city informed that the plan has been prepared and approval from the Municipal Commissioner has been received and the same will be submitted shortly.
 7. Several cities (Rishikesh, Jammu, Raebareli, Amritsar, Khurja, Mandi and Ghaziabad) have requested for approval for implementing activities beyond 5 key activities.
 8. Cities have requested for consultants, as there is a vacancy in their city.

After detailed deliberations, the following decisions were taken for implementation and necessary action:

- i. Cities should accelerate to submit their annual action plan of FY 2025-26 on PRANA portal and respective plans to be reviewed and approved by CPCB. It is also accelerated and coordinated from state level also

(Action: Municipal Corporations of 95 cities and CPCB)

- ii. Cities should submit their saturation action plan through PRANA portal and respective plans to be reviewed and approved by CPCB

(Action: Municipal Corporations of 39 cities and CPCB)

- iii. Cities should attain minimum 75% fund utilization, for attaining eligibility for FY 2025–26 fund release.

**(Action: Municipal Corporations of 80 cities and
CPCB)**

- iv. Vijayawada to submit status of property tax floor rate notification aligned with State GSDP growth

(Action: Vijayawada Municipal Corporation)

- v. Expedite submission of Utilisation Certificates for third tranche (FY 2024–25)

(Action: SPCBs of Chhattisgarh, Uttarakhand, Odisha, Punjab)

- vi. Cities to restrict their action plans to 5 key activities mentioned in Ministry's OM dated 14.5.2025.

(Action: 82 NACs covered under CP Scheme)

- vii. Process for engagement of vacant consultants is to be completed.

(Action: CPCB)

viii. Upload SLMIC recommendations and supporting documents on PRANA portal

(Action: Municipal Corporation of Jharkhand, Rajasthan, Telangana)
